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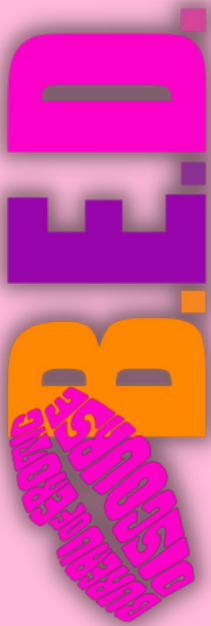
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Meet BED

WE ARE AN OUTREACH CAMP



In BED, we teach sex-positive consent education to solve a terrible problem. In 2004, after a consent violation, a burner said, “Somebody should do something about that.” Out of civic responsibility, BED was born.

Since then, we’ve reached tens of thousands of people with our workshops, buttons, and training, but we’re always striving to improve our consent education program.

BED has gone virtual to help camps create their own safe containers at Burning Man! We’ve adapted to using our online tools to spread the message of consent. Previously, a BED representative would have come to your camp during Burning Man to gift a BED Talk, where we are now training the community to have a **BEDucator in every camp**.

We have had over 200+ signups as we transitioned to an online environment this year, and *BED campers are expected to have completed the [BEDucator Program](#)*.

BEDucators are members of other camps at Burning Man that have volunteered themselves as the known person to foreshadow their camp's boundaries by creating their own unique Consent Policy and Problem Resolution Process.

BEDucators are not members of our physical camp, but of our outreach efforts. We, as BED, gift them the *discourse* around the Consent Enforcement Process and what resources are available for when their campmates get into escalated situations.

If you're here, you have a passion for consent education, sexual assault prevention, and harm reduction while believing in supporting people with a similar mission.



WE BELIEVE IN THE **11** PRINCIPLES OF BURNING MAN

Burning Man has 10 Official Principles, we've been advocating for the 11th Principle of Consent since 2004 by community demand

Radical Inclusion - Gifting - Decommodification - Radical Self Reliance - Radical Self Expression - Communal Effort - Civic Responsibility - Leave No Trace - Participation - Immediacy

ENTHUSIASTIC CONSENT

The Bureau of Erotic Discourse is considered a volunteer work camp under Burning Man Emergency Services. That's where your ticket came from. The "D" in BED stands for Discourse, which means to have a conversation.

No one in our camp is expected to be the expert in dealing with consent violations; rather, we are the camp that normalizes the conversation around this high-level topic by asking questions, learning, and listening to our community's experiences.

[The 10 Principles of Burning Man](#)

Burning Man is an experiment, and we are diving into the sandbox. The principles are our way of allowing organized chaos into this overwhelming experience that is a gathering of a global community in a temporary city of *80,000 people*.

We're here to decipher rumors from reality. When it comes to consent in a culture of questionable mindsets and community members with real feelings, there has been a begging for the 11th principle of Enthusiastic Consent, and you are part of that movement in our culture.

Many camps have adopted our camp's Consent Policy and Problem Resolution Process to live the 11th Principle.



BED CONSENT POLICY

We believe Enthusiastic Consent is the 11th Principle of Burning Man. We believe we can show people how to express themselves by normalizing the conversation surrounding Consent. When our community feels as comfortable discussing Consent as they do discussing food, everyone will benefit. We believe that Consent works best when discussed up front. By having the conversation before anybody steps foot on the playa we strive to foster trust and understanding so that everyone can

- **Feel safe to explore—sexually and otherwise**
- **Confident about expressing boundaries**
- **Empowered to speak up**
- **Conditioned to hearing “no”**

Consent for any physical engagement (touching, hugging, dancing, etc.) is required from everyone within our camp. Without a freely given, specific, informed, and enthusiastic “YES”, there is no consent. Consent is always reversible and retractable at any time. Violations of an individual’s boundaries may result in a Teachable Moment or immediate removal from the camp with the potential never to be allowed to return.



PROBLEM/RESOLUTION

BED PROBLEM RESOLUTION

Tier 1: "Hey! How's it going?"

The point of the "Hey! How's it going?" is an unassuming way to get more information. Anyone can execute this step. Our Camp Leads are tasked with approaching escalations reported to them after campmates have practiced this step themselves. When an incident is escalated to our leads, they approach the parties for more information. This is done by conversing with the parties involved to get their sides.

Tier 2: The Teachable Moment

The Teachable Moment is verbally stating our boundaries. Anyone can execute this, and we encourage you to seek help if you do not have the capacity to do this step alone. With the parties' consent, the able person mediates the escalation by seeking a clear, verbalized boundary. Verbalizing the boundary draws a line in the sand; another escalation could result in a temporary or permanent ban.

Tier 2.5: Camp Lead Meeting

If a Teachable Moment needs to be repeated, or there's a complex incident regarding any of the 11 principles, then the Camp Leads are tasked with collaborating on disciplinary action. Our minds are greater as a group, and our capacity to solve problems is supported when we have more minds together. It's understood not all of the Camp Leads may be present at any given time. Still, any capably-minded leads are to participate in this portion of contemplating disciplinary action including temporary or permanent bans.

Camp Leads (BED Heads) are Morgan "Momo" Kellar & Amanda "Danger Kitten" Joan, Brian "Space Monkey" Riel, Drew "Captain Rainbow Sprinkle Sparkles Sunshine" Riel, and Todd "Rooster" Vickers. Michael Ismail is the Camp Culture Lead and is tasked with this handling complaints if there is an escalation against those BED Heads named. He can be reached at michael@thriveandgrowgardens.com

Tier 3: Removal

Temporary Ban

A temporary ban can apply to a campmate or guest for varying reasons (over-intoxication, multiple Teachable Moments, intentionally disregarding our principles, etc...) Anyone in camp with a leadership title, which applies to Camp Culture Lead, LNT Lead, Kitchen Lead, or other Camp Leads, can remove these individuals. Rangers are the most common roamers and have the essential resource of wearing radios that escalate outside of our camp. Rangers are volunteers with the necessary tools and can lead the situation by radioing for assistance.

Permanent Ban

A permanent ban must be so severe that a campmate or guest can never return to our camp again. This **MUST** go through our Camp Leads with as many Camp Leads present as possible to vote on the disciplinary action. This Problem Resolution process will take place before a final decision is made.

WE ARE CONSENT AMBASSADORS

According to BED's definition, a Consent Ambassador is an individual well-versed in the Consent Enforcement Process, having engaged with the BEDucator Program. While this doesn't crown us experts, it does make us knowledgeable representatives of Camp BED. We serve as active voices championing the culture of consent at gatherings, and we're continually striving to better embody the principles we advocate for daily.

WE KNOW THE RESOURCES FOR BURNERS WHO COME TO US WITH THE UNFORTUNATE STORY OF SEXUAL ASSAULT.

Our primary goal is to prevent sexual assault by emphasizing consent education. However, when prevention falls short, individuals seek assistance at our camp. Please acquaint yourself with the BED Resource Guide, which prominently features the Survivor Advocacy Team (S.A.T.) located at Station 6 on 5:15 & Esplanade.

We've encountered burners who've shared their traumatic experiences. If someone confides in you, be prepared to assist. The resource guide will be displayed on vinyl within our camp. We encourage you to visit and express gratitude for their invaluable services. Your familiarity will be crucial should you need to accompany a burner to the S.A.T.

IN A CRISIS?

Catchy, right? The 9:00 & C and 3:00 & C Portals will have the crisis intention services you need.

EMERGENCY SERVICES

Look for the lit red cross and the heroes in yellow shirts. They provide Black Rock City with firefighting, emergency medical, and crisis intervention services. Emergency Services are not part of any law enforcement or outside agency. **They are also located at 5:15 & Esplanade.**

ZENDO

If you're feeling overwhelmed, having an intense trip, or in need of harm reduction services, trained peer support- volunteers from the Zendo Project and the Green Dot team are there to help you through your stress.

BLACK ROCK RANGERS

Look for the khaki-colored clothing roaming around the playa. Rangers help mediate disagreements, address safety concerns, and find lost kids. They are not law enforcement, but they can radio for them. **They are also located at 5:45 & Esplanade.**

"I'VE BEEN SEXUALLY ASSAULTED"

We hear you. We believe you. It's not your fault. We're here to help.

NO TOUCHING! S.A.T. TEAM

If someone comes to you with a sexual assault allegation, **do not touch them** unless they ask. Let them know they are strong and be an ear for support. The survivor makes the final decision on if they want to report.

The Survivor Advocacy Team is located next to Medical on 5:15 & Esplanade (Station 6), where you can file a report in a secluded area. Sexual assaults are considered a must-report among staff. You can also report at any Medical Station or Ranger Outpost. Remember 9/3/C!

RAPE KITS

Survivors are flown to Reno for an examination, where they will get a room, hot shower, change of clothes, and meals accommodated.

Sharing a meal is a cherished tradition for us! We eagerly anticipate the opportunity to bond as a family, embracing all our unique quirks and tales. Our dedicated campers have stepped up to prepare our feasts. Let's extend a heartfelt THANK YOU to them for nourishing us and fostering moments where we can grow closer together.



BRC PASSPORT PROGRAM

We're proud members of the Black Rock City Passport Program! Much like an actual passport, burners journey across the playa, collecting stamps at each stop — and we're a destination! The pink vested N.O.A.H. will have our unique stamp ready to commemorate their visit. If you encounter a fellow burner, spread the word about our camp and help them discover WHO WE ARE. It's a wonderful opportunity to bond with newcomers to the community and spread our outreach!

CAMP N.O.A.H

The BED N.O.A.H. stands for BED's "Number One AssHole!" Armed with their all-knowing pink clipboard, they serve as the go-to volunteer for burners and campers seeking information or help from our camp.



BED TALKS

We have a select number of BED Talks delivered by our BED campers. Historically, these talks were our primary outreach method before we transitioned to the BEDucator Program and began assigning a BEDucator to each camp. We're honoring the camps that decided to have us come and give these talks.

ENJOY CAMP AMMENITIES

REMEMBER LNT

As a burner, one of our main principles is leaving absolutely no trace behind whatsoever. See a hair on the playa? This is MOOP (Matter Out of Place)! If it's a piece of glitter that can fit in your baggie we expect you to pick it up. This is not just a camp mandatory but a playa mandatory!

Guess what? If BLM comes in next year and decides we have not left the land to code there is NO BURNING MAN the following year. Do your part to keep this place alive or else it won't be around for us to experience next year.

CAMP SHOWER

- Keep your showers limit to 1 gallon of personal water! LNT also means the water that you use so if it can't evaporate you're helping take it out!
- **The EVAP POND ONLY FOR CAMP SHOWER WATER ONLY!**
- **If the pond is full - do not shower**
- **NO SHOWERS EVERYDAY**

POWER

- Feel free to plug in your small devices at the solar charging stations located around camp (Marni, Snacks, DangerKitten).
- If solar charging is not possible, you can also charge small devices using the camp generators that are currently on. **Please don't disconnect any cables.**
- If you need to use the kitchen generator, please coordinate with Todd, Brian, Eric, or Drew.

SHIPPING CONTAINER

- We just acquired the shipping container this year! We hope to be able to climb on top and get a killer view of burn!
- You may use this for storage with the permission of the camp leads. **LNT applies to this container!**
- **If you would like to gift something of value to the camp please get with camp leads** to see if we have the space and can inventory your gift.

REMEMBER LNT

KITCHEN

THE KITCHEN IS THE HEART OF CAMP, BUT IT'S ALSO THE MOOPIEST PLACE IN ALL OF CAMP. THEREFORE WE HAVE TO RUN A TIGHT SHIP. PLEASE SEE BELOW FOR KITCHEN GUIDELINES.

- **Allergies: This is a big one!! We have campmates that have severe allergies so, to make sure everyone is safe the kitchen has banned nuts in the kitchen*.**
- Clean up after yourself!
- Dispose of your trash responsibly.
- After use, seal items and store them properly to maintain freshness and minimize waste.
- Clean tables, stoves, and grills immediately after use.
- Sort trash: regular, burnable, and recyclables.
- Ensure coolers are tightly sealed to preserve food.
- Turn off gas on stoves and grills to prevent hazards.
- If possible, take a trash bag with you when you leave.

*Hazelnuts are okay.

OPPORTUNITIES

(5) CAMP SHIFT REQUIREMENTS

When you've signed up for kitchen duty, a B.E.D. talk, or any other camp responsibilities, you must follow through. Participating in our camp duties and BED message is not only fun, but a bonding experience!

If you're hurt or sick or for any other reason cannot cover your shift, ask someone to do it for you and trade with them. If you miss a shift, you will be asked to do even more to regain your status. If you flake, you won't be invited back.

PORT-OH! PROJECT

- Drive to all the portapotties to hang up and take down our consent posters

BED BUDDY

- BED Buddies are mentors to our registered BEDucators before burn

PLAYA OUTREACH

- Go to camps, center camp. BM Radio, etc to check in with consent policies and give talks

BUTTON DELIVERY

- Take BED buttons out to camps that completed the BEDucator Program

DOMMY

- Use your Dom skills or your mom skills to enforcing water/shade breaks. Bring snacks and positivity to the team. Keep them on task.

PLANNED SHENNANIGANS

- Create fun outings for other camp members. Take them on an art tour, out to a special show, out to the temple, or center camp for a talk. Support BEDucated Camp events

LNT

- Leave No Trace. Conduct MOOP sweeps of the camp, pick up the general areas, prevent MOOP. Floof up the lounge and hang out areas. Collect recycle and use camp wagon to take to recycle camp.

ICE & FUEL RUNS

- Run to Artica or Hell Station to bring back water or gas

PLACEMENT GREETER

- Check campers in and show them to their assigned location.

FUEL PICK UP

- Head out to Hell's Station with the camp golf cart or wagon and fill up fuel containers and come back. Ensure all generators are full of fuel.

CAMP MEALS

- Prep and cook a meal for the whole camp. Then clean and organize the workspace. Please use the meal sheet to state what you are making and to check for allergens.

CAMP N.O.A.H.

- You're it! On-Duty person at camp. You get to wear a super cool vest, interface with visitors, oversee shift schedules, and answer camper's questions. Keep an eye on public spaces as the Number One AssHole

BUILD/STRIKE

- Un/load and organize supplies/structures. Map out and start building & deconstructing camp structures. Requires working in the heat and dust.

STAY SAFE: CARBON MONOXIDE AND HEAT STROKE

1. CARBON MONOXIDE:

GENERATORS POWER CAMP ACTIVITIES BUT EMIT DANGEROUS, ODORLESS CARBON MONOXIDE.

KEEP SAFE BY:

- NEVER SLEEPING NEAR GENERATORS.
- WATCH FOR SIGNS OF POISONING: HEADACHES, DIZZINESS, NAUSEA, WEAKNESS, OR SHORT BREATH.
- IF YOU SUSPECT CARBON MONOXIDE EXPOSURE, GET FRESH AIR AND SEEK MEDICAL HELP.

2. GUARD AGAINST HEAT STROKE:

- STAY HYDRATED, EVEN IF NOT THIRSTY (REMEMBER PISS CLEAR!).
- RECOGNIZE HEAT STROKE SYMPTOMS: HIGH BODY TEMP, RAPID PULSE, HEADACHE, CONFUSION, UNCONSCIOUSNESS.
- TAKE ACTION: MOVE TO SHADE, HYDRATE, COOL BODY WITH DAMP CLOTHS OR FAN IF HEAT STROKE SIGNS APPEAR.

RECOGNIZING DISTRESS:

LISTEN TO YOUR BODY AND ACT FAST IF:

- FEELING DIZZY OR NAUSEOUS: REST IN SHADE AND HYDRATE.
- HEART RACING: FIND COOLER SPOT, TAKE A BREAK.
- CONFUSED OR DISORIENTED: GET HELP FROM CAMP MATES, CONSIDER MEDICAL AID.
- UNCONSCIOUS: CALL FOR HELP, PROVIDE BASIC FIRST AID IF ABLE.

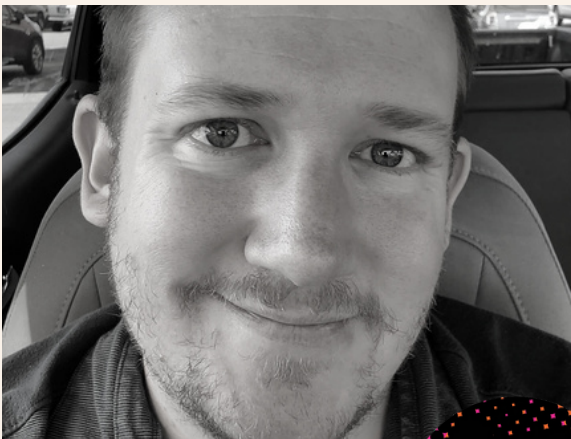

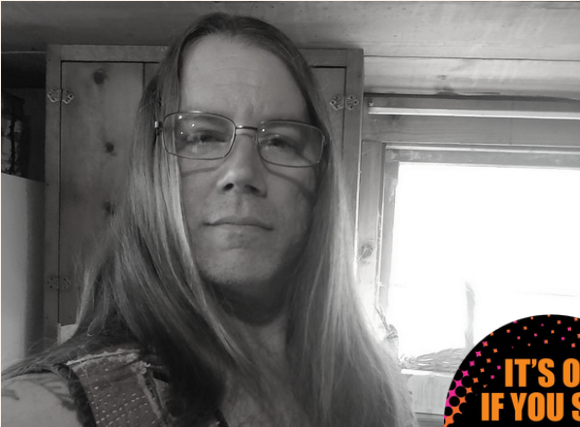
